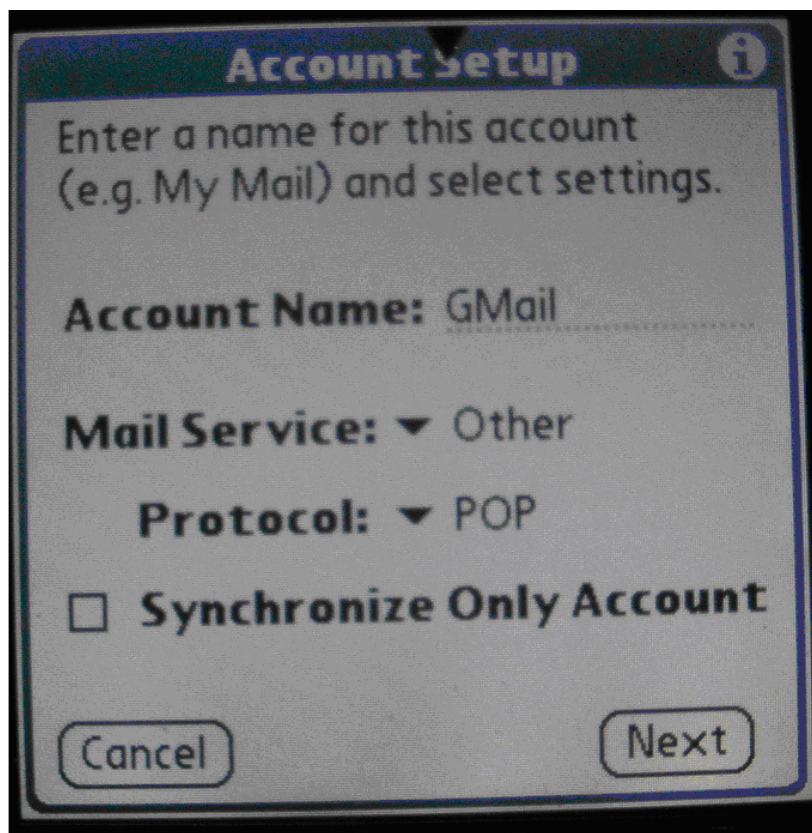
Setting GMail account with versamail 2.51 using streamyx ISP account can be daunting. I tried several ways and found ways around to be successful.



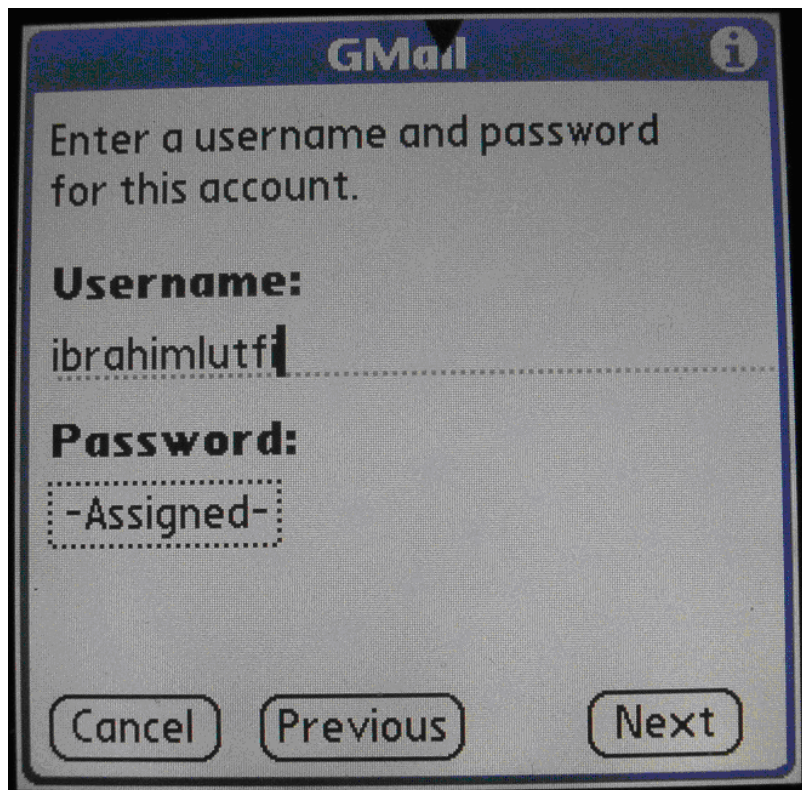
For account setup, tap New.



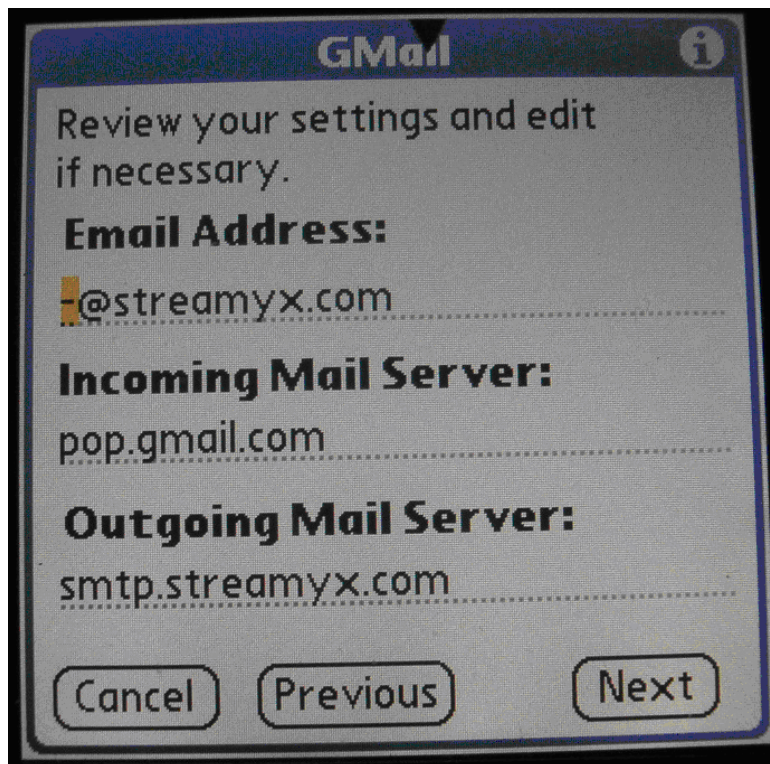
I chose an account name of GMail. The mail service is Other and the protocol used is POP.



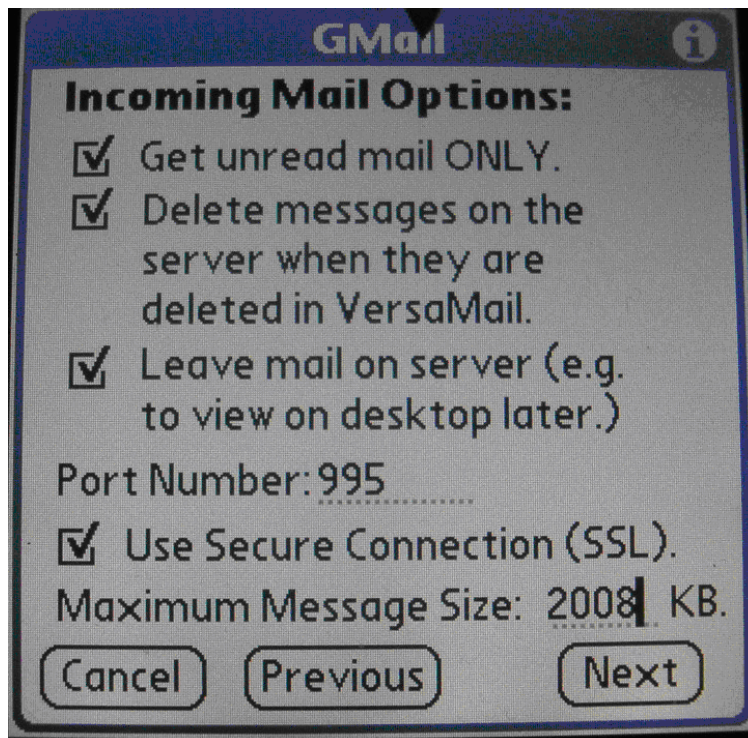
The Username is the username I have registered with GMail and the password is your password.



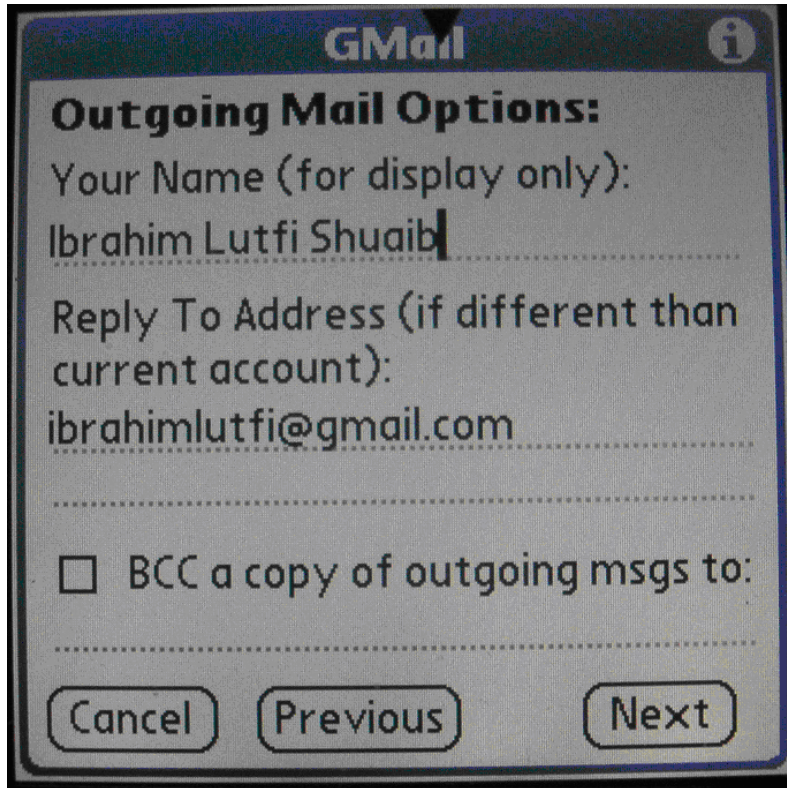
When using streamyx as account, the email address is ~@streamyx.com. For some reason this work around seems to work. The incoming server is pop.gmail.com and outgoing mail server is smtp.streamyx.com.



For incoming mail options, I have used the setting as below. Others might want to use other options. The port number is 995 and please use secure connection (SSL).



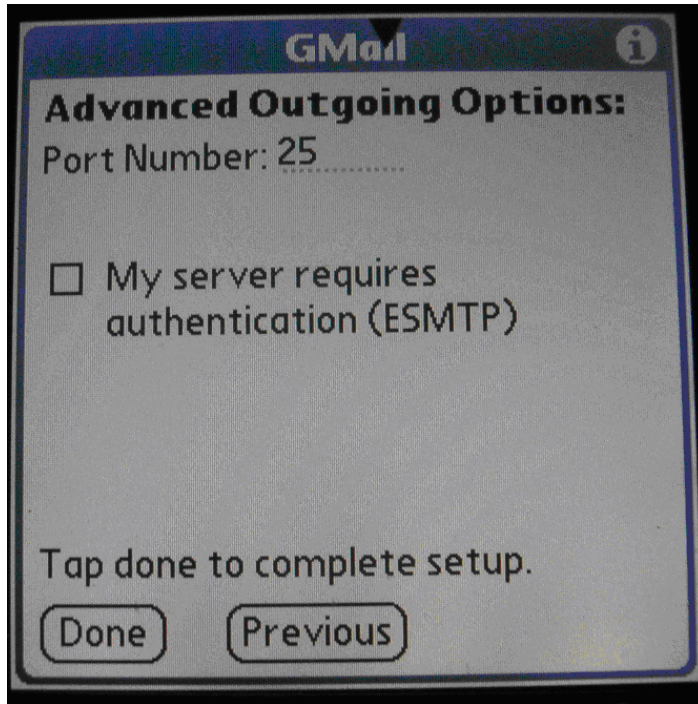
Outgoing mail option is used as below and the reply address must be put in as it is different than the current account used previously.



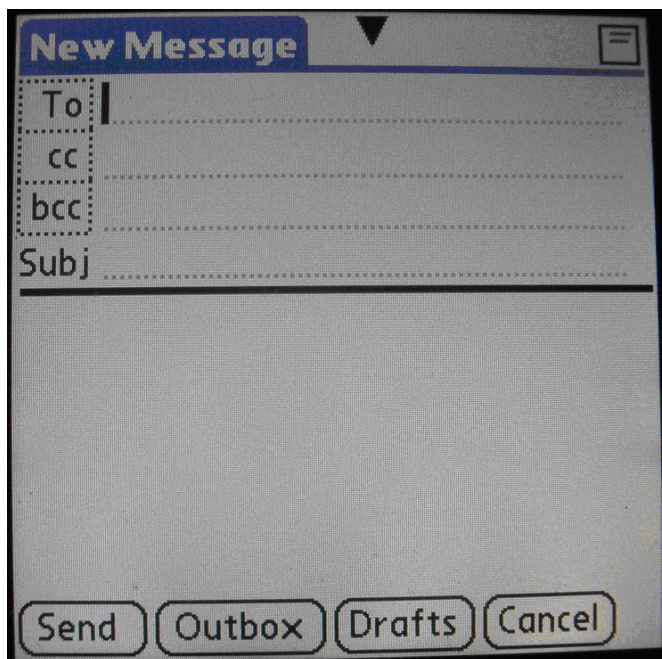
I don't like to attach signature to messages but some people prefer to have one.



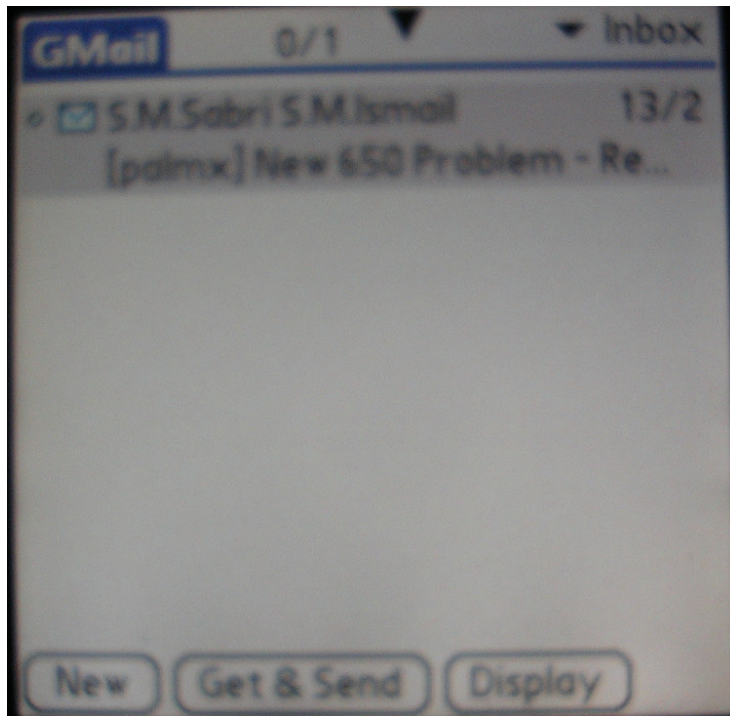
A port number of 25 is used and the server does not require authentication.



After a new message is created, if it send immediately, it does not seem to work. The work around is to put the message in outbox first.



The message is then send by pressing get and send button.
